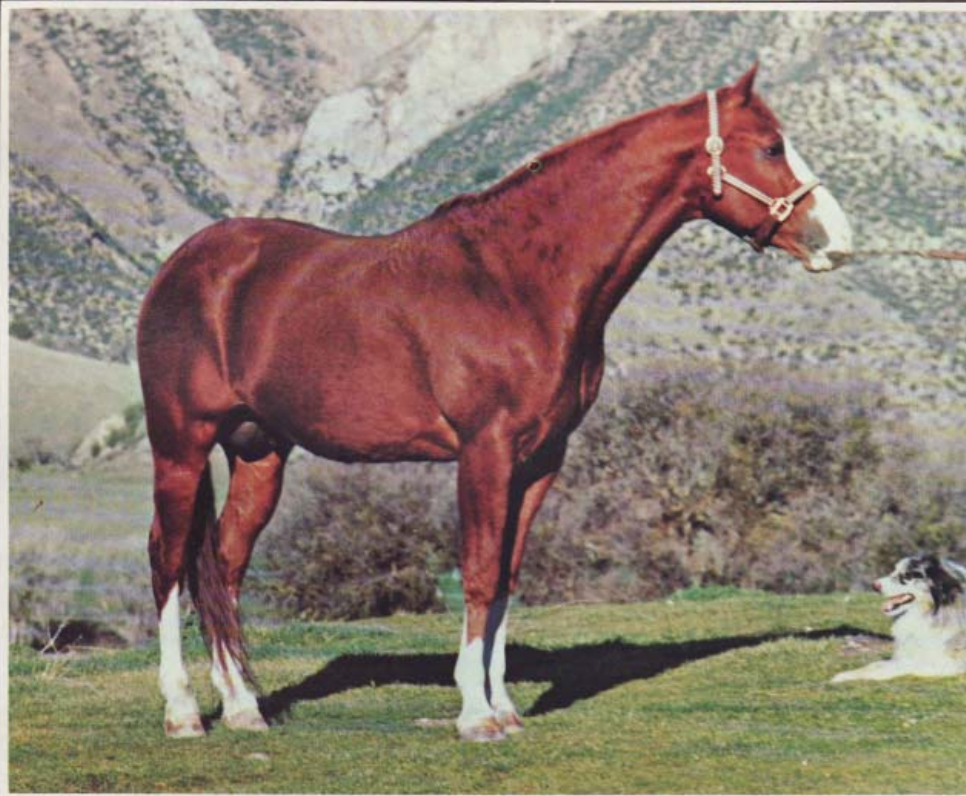

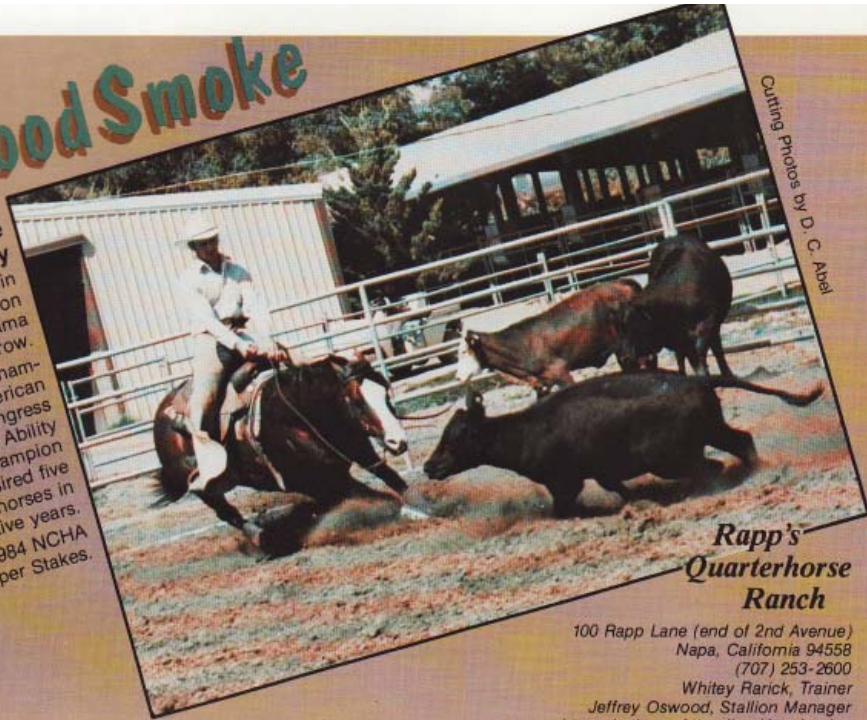

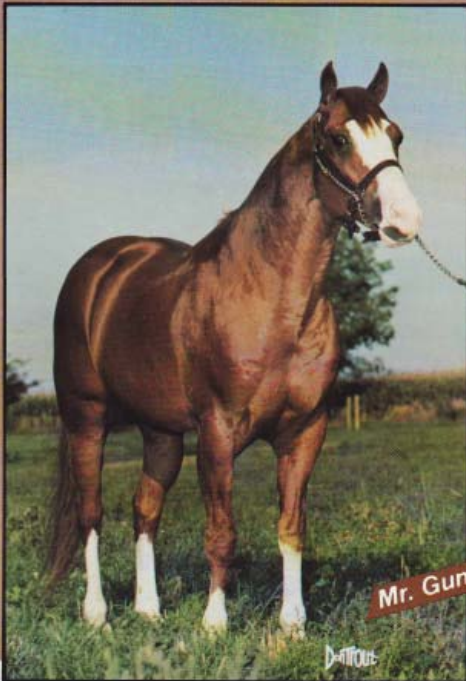

Obituary

Mr GunSmoke



Mr GunSmoke, a leading sire of cutting, reining and working cow horses died Thursday, August 11, at the age of 22.

The stallion, owned by Rapps Quarter Horses of Napa, California at the time of his death, was a Superior Cutting horse and sire of the same.

His pedigree traced to Leo, Question Mark, Chigger and to Oklahoma Star through both his sire and dam. He was sired by Rondo Leo and was out of Kansas Cindy by Kansas Star.

A noted sire, he is the only horse to produce get that were champions of each of the following events: NCHA Futurity, CRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity, World Champion Stock Horse Classic, AQHA Congress Reining Champion and AQHA Congress Cutting Maturity Champion. He also sired two horses, Kit's Smoke and Smoke's Belle, that earned the CRCHA Supreme Champion Reined Cow Horse Award.

Mr GunSmoke was inducted into the Working Cow Horse Hall of Fame in 1980 during the Snaffle Bit Futurity. □
