- ☆ **LORANE** 3130 by Zandy 2796, grey color. Her colts that have raced are: Grey Question "AA" at 220 to 330 and "AAA" at 350 to 440; Lorane's Vandy "AAA" at every distance. Her 2-yr-old daughter Miss Okmulgee will start this year. She has sorrel stud colt foaled Jan. 16 by Vandy, Jr. 20833 and is bred to Hard Twist.
- ☆ **LORANE QUESTION** 14,676 by Question Mark P-3247, grey color, full sister to Grey Question, is mother to Vandy's Question, "AA" horse at all distances. Was bred Feb. 15 to Leo.
- ☆ **YEAGER'S LADY J. A.** P-3442 by Will Stead, bay color, is mother to F. L. King Bee, "AA" horse at all distances, she will foal to Joe Bob this year and then will be bred to Hard Twist.
- ☆ **GALE'S LADY SOCKS** 23,392 by Paul by Paul Ell, sorrel color, is mother of Lady Vandy, rated "A", and was third in the Quarter mile Futurity at Big Spring, Texas, and also ran the 220 in :12.2 at Del Rio when she was 17 months of age.
- ☆ **F. L. PEE WEE** P-2885 by Peter McCue, Jr., red dun, is a very consistent brood mare, all of her colts are show horses and one is on the rodeo circuit and one is racing. She will foal to Joe Bob and will be bred to Nowata Star.
- ☆ **MARY JANE W.** 13,766 by Pretty Boy P-2229, dun color. She has produced four show colts in a row, one was top selling colt at the National Western Stock Show this January, will foal to Poco Bueno and will be bred to Nowata Star.
- ☆ **F. L. GREY BAKER** P-11,190 by Big Nigger, grey color. One of my better brood mares. 2 of her colts are at stud in Oklahoma and Austin Moore has one of her fillies in his brood mare band. Her colts are really tops, will foal to Nowata Star and will be bred to Monsieur Joe.
- ☆ **SUSAN** P-2288 by Blackburn P-2228, dun color. I purchased this mare from E. P. Waggoner and she has consistently produced some of his higher priced horses. She will foal to Pretty Buck and will be bred to Nowata Star.
- ☆ **DINA WAGGONER** P-33,900 by Pretty Boy P-2229, black color. 2 of her colts are working in the rodeo arena, Andy Curtis has one for a dogging horse. She has a brown filly that was a top race horse in western Oklahoma. All her colts are good using horses. She will foal to Nowata Star and will be bred back to him.
- ☆ **ROYAL FORD LADY** 23,754 by Royal Ford, grey color. Some thought this was the top mare in the Waggoner sale last fall. She will foal to Poco Bueno and will be bred back to Nowata Star.
- ☆ **ETHEL G.** 6836 by Mr. Whiskline, brown color. She is in foal to Nowata Star and will be bred back to him. This will be her first colt as she has been used in rodeos all the time. She is the best bulldogging horse I ever rode. Her colts should do everything.
